

General Authorisation No. 2 – Coronavirus

Essential emergency repairs by car, motorcycle and bicycle repair businesses in respect of vehicles of essential workers

Further to its powers under paragraph 1(2)(e) of the Direction of the Committee *for* Health & Social Care made on 29th March 2020 ("the Direction"), the Committee hereby disapplies the prohibition on entering and remaining on premises under the Direction, in relation to persons reasonably and necessarily providing essential emergency repairs to vehicles of essential workers.

This Authorisation applies to car, motorcycle and bicycle mechanics and repairers and necessary management and support staff ("emergency vehicle repair personnel") who reasonably and necessarily provide essential emergency repair services in respect of the vehicles of essential workers whilst the Direction remains in force.

When providing services in reliance on this Authorisation, emergency vehicle repair personnel must adopt practices designed to minimise wherever possible and practical risks to health, including maintenance of social distancing of at least 2 metres and such other measures as the Committee or Medical Officer of Health may from time to time advise or direct.

Unless revoked or varied, this Authorisation has effect from 1520 hours on Sunday 29th March, 2020 until 2359 hours on 7th April, 2020.
